- Be treated with dignity.
- An equal opportunity to strive for success.
- Receive qualified adult leadership.
- Play as a child and not as an adult.
- Have fun in sports.
- Share in the leadership and decision-making of their sport.
- Participate in a safe and healthy environment.

HCYP BASKETBALL COACHES' CODE of ETHICS

The coach must be aware that he can be either a positive or a negative influence upon the development of the athlete. In all of his personal contacts with athletes, officials, parents, the media, and the public, the coach shall strive to set an example of the highest ethical and moral conduct. In keeping with that goal, the following ethical guidelines should be observed by all HCYP MS Basketball League Coaches:

1. The coach shall never place the value of winning above the value of instilling the highest desirable ideals of character.
2. The coach **must** always consider the personal safety of the athlete.
3. The coach shall be thoroughly acquainted with the rules and regulations of competition, HCYP Coaches Manual, and shall be responsible for their interpretation to team members. The coach shall not try to seek an advantage by circumventing the spirit or letter of the rules.
4. Game officials shall have the respect and support of the coach. The coach shall not indulge in conduct which will incite the players or spectators against the officials. **Public criticism of the officials or players is unethical.**
5. The coach should respect his opponents, display gracious behavior during competition and require his players to conduct themselves in similar fashion. Before and after the contest, rival coaches should meet and exchange friendly greetings to set the correct tone for the event
6. Coaches **shall** actively use their influence to enhance sportsmanship by spectators.
7. Only the **Head Coach** of the team is permitted to stand at the player's bench.
8. Only the **Head Coach** of the team is permitted to address Officials in a respectful manner. If the head coach receives a technical foul or a member of his coaching staff or players bench receives a technical foul, the head coach will lose the coaches box for the remainder of the half (be seated).

Any additional technical fouls issued by be **subject to ejection**. Ejection will result in one (1) game suspension for the coach, subject to review by the league commissioner for further disciplinary action.

HCYP BASKETBALL COACHES' PLEDGE

As a coach, parents have placed their children in your care. You will be playing a key role in their development and many of the memories they make while playing on your team will stay with them a lifetime. It is important to understand that your words and actions will have an impact on how these children view sports, competition, their teammates and most importantly – themselves.

1. I will remember that we are youth basketball coaches and that the game is for the children not the adults. I understand children participate in basketball to have fun and learn the game. Winning is secondary.
2. I will be a positive role model for the children, encouraging sportsmanship, showing respect and courtesy and demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game and practice.
3. I will remind our team and fans to exhibit good sportsmanship at all times, both when winning and when losing.
4. I will not ridicule or berate any child for making a mistake but will encourage them to learn from their mistakes and strive to continuously improve.
5. I will teach our players both the rules of the game and the league rules. I will make our player's parents aware of the rules. I will abide by the letter of the rules and the spirit of the rules.
6. Our team will play by the rules and abide by both the letter and spirit of the league rules.
7. I will never harass, ridicule or criticize officials, players, opposing coaches or spectators either directly or indirectly at any time. If necessary, I will inform our player's parents and fans that this behavior is unacceptable.
8. I will not use profane language or gestures.
9. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the players ahead of any personal desire we may have to win.
10. I will communicate with parents regarding practices, games, and other team & league matters.
11. I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all players.
12. I will abide by the rules and policies of the Howard County Youth Program (HCYP) Basketball League.
13. I understand that I am subject to the procedures outlined in our zero tolerance disciplinary policy were I to violate any of these rules.

HCYP BASKETBALL PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Coaches are responsible to ensure that all of their players' parents receive a copy of this Parent Code of Conduct, sign it and return to the head coach as part of each player's team registration requirement.

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the children, not the adults.
2. I (and my guests) will follow the rules and regulations of the Howard County Youth Program (HCYP) Basketball League.
3. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game and practice.
4. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any referee, coach, player or parent, such as booing or taunting, refusing to show sportsmanship (including gestures like post game handshakes) ; or use profane language or gestures.
5. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the players.
6. I will never harass, ridicule or criticize officials, players, opposing coaches or spectators either directly or indirectly at any time, before, during or after games or practices.
7. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
8. I will teach my child to treat other players, coaches, referees and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
9. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the players ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
10. I will be responsible for any children attending the games in my care, and will maintain visual contact with any minor children in my care at all times (no minor children are allowed in the gym or school hallways with parental supervision).
11. I understand that violations of the Parent Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action outlined in the Zero Tolerance Policy.

HCYP Code of Conduct and Zero Tolerance Policy

HCYP Basketball enforces a zero-tolerance policy for violations of its Parent's Code of Conduct and Coaches' Pledge as presented hereto, collectively referred to as The HCYP Basketball Codes of Conduct and Ethics. Violations of The HCYP Codes of Conduct and Ethics by spectators, coaches and/or players shall be subject to corrective action as outlined below:

1. If during the game, the league commissioner, referee, or league official observes behavior that violates The HCYP Basketball Codes of Conduct and Ethics, a warning shall be issued to the individual or individuals involved to immediately discontinue the offending behavior.
2. If the individual or individuals persist with the offending behavior, they will be asked leave the game (they must exit the facility) and will be subject to a minimum suspension of one game. Play shall not continue until the offending individual(s) has/have left the game and exited the court and immediate gym area).
3. If the behavior takes place following a game or at any other time, the individual or individuals involved will be ask to leave the premises immediately. Failure to do will result in an automatic one game suspension.
4. Any individual violating The HCYP Basketball Codes of Conduct and Ethics may be subject to a full year suspension and a requirement to appear before the HCYP Disciplinary Council before being allowed to return to any games or practices.
